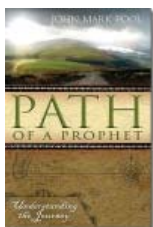
From the desk of Steve Shultz:

Joseph - The Fullness of Blessing

"Joseph is a fruitful tree, a fruitful tree beside a fountain. His branches reach over the wall. He has been attacked by archers, who shot at him and harassed him. But his bow remained strong, and his arms were strengthened by the Mighty One of Jacob, the Shepherd, the Rock of Israel.

"May the God of your ancestors help you; may the Almighty bless you with the blessings of the heavens above, blessings of the earth beneath, and blessings of the breasts and womb. May the blessings of your ancestors be greater than the blessings of the eternal mountains, reaching to the utmost bounds of the everlasting hills. These blessings will fall on the head of Joseph, who is a prince among his brothers." Genesis 49:22-26

The Fullness of Blessing for Joseph is indeed overflowing. What Jacob says of him, is history as well as prophecy. Jacob reminds him of the difficulties and fiery darts of temptations he had formerly struggled through. His faith did not fail, but through his trials he bore all his burdens with firmness, and did not do anything unbecoming. Jacob was well acquainted with this life message, for he had an authority through a conclusion of walking out this reality.

All our strength for resisting temptations and bearing afflictions comes from God; His grace is sufficient. Joseph became the shepherd of Israel - to take care of his father and family; also the stone of Israel - their foundation and strong support. In this, as in many other things, Joseph was a remarkable type from the Good Shepherd and tried Cornerstone of the whole Church of God.

Blessings are promised to Joseph's descendants, typical of the vast and everlasting blessings that come upon the spiritual seed of Christ. Jacob blessed all his sons, but especially Joseph, "who was separated from his brethren." Not only separated in Egypt, but, possessing eminent dignity, and was more devoted to God.

In the days of Joseph, that was a huge blessing to be proliferated through the seed of their ancestors to increase the family of God. As women gave birth to more Israelites, this was viewed as a sign of fruitfulness.

We are entering a season of the fullness of God's blessings as we abandon the pains from poor choices in the past. Let them go, offer them on the altar of grace before God, and feel the refreshing blessings begin to flow again in your life, your restored relationships, and your deepened intimacy with our Father.

Joseph and Jacob - a Message of God's Grace

When Joseph was reunited through famine with his brothers who had sold him into slavery, God was bringing a conclusion to the way human flesh deals with problems. This is one of the best messages of God's grace for His own people that could be cited in the entire Bible. Joseph could have had his brothers executed, yet he displayed overwhelming mercy and became the redeemer for not only his immediate family, but also national Israel.

Jacob was very knowledgeable of God's ability to turn tragedy into triumph, demonstrating that if we will purpose to view God in the process, then this will allow the stones in our paths to become the very "Gates of God!" **This year, allow your stones in your path to become your "Bethel of blessings!"**

"At sundown he arrived at a good place to set up camp and stopped there for the night. Jacob found a stone for a pillow and lay down to sleep. As he slept, he dreamed of a stairway that reached from Earth to Heaven. And he saw the angels of God going up and down on it.

"At the top of the stairway stood the LORD, and he said, 'I am the LORD, the God of your grandfather Abraham and the God of your father, Isaac. The ground you are lying on belongs to you. I will give it to you and your descendants.'

"Then Jacob woke up and said, 'Surely the LORD is in this place, and I wasn't even aware of it.' He was afraid and said, 'What an awesome place this is! It is none other than the house of God - the gateway to Heaven!'" Genesis 28:11-13, 16-17

Jacob went on to pay a great price for the valuable lessons of a pathway from being a trickster to being triumphant!

Joseph was just one such reminder, yet in the end, God turned all things around to bring us the message this year offers:

2009 is the Birth of Your Turnaround!

Joseph was Jacob's favored son. *Yosef* is the Hebrew translation for *Joseph* and means "he increases or enlarges or becomes more full." As this time of revelation came to light, that his brothers lied to their father, it lets us know that in 2009, we must let go of any sinful patterns of our past. This will bring a necessary healing of old iniquitous ways to a required conclusion.

Grace is sufficient for all our needs. "And He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me" (2 Corinthians 12:9).

We cannot move forward without some very important conclusions to past mistakes. This will enable us to walk in the gratitude of grace from our Lord as opposed to wandering in the "wilderness of wants" forever. We must view what God desires as our lifestyle and not succumb to human efforts of "business."

This is a real picture of the year of 2009 - including the tet symbol that represents a new wineskin or even a "fertile womb." Tet is the Hebrew symbol, or letter for the number nine, which symbolizes end, conclusion, fullness of blessings, and evangelist. Another meaning for the number nine is conclusion.

God will now "Joseph" (Yosef) or enlarge our blessings into their fullness. We are in a season of both chronos and kairos times. Our chronos will be a season of fullness if we will begin to allow the spirit of travail to cause the kairos moment of God's orders for new birth to soon occur.

2009 is the time you and your family will be encouraged by God to forget the past, embrace your fullness of blessings and take that message to a very hurting world.

2009 is a Year of Evangelistic Harvest!

The year 2009 will indeed become the beginning of one of the most unprecedented times of harvest this nation and the world has ever experienced. We must be ready for such reaping. Reaping is best for those who have prepared their nets. We must now have our visions of a move of God raised higher. *“The thief’s purpose is to steal and kill and destroy. My purpose is to give life in all its fullness.”
John 10:10 NLT emphases added.*

Perissos, pronounced per-is-sos); from a root word peri, which is used in various applications, of place, cause or time in the sense of beyond the time. A true meaning of this word is best described in superabundant (in quantity) or superior (in quality). As a noun it is preeminence and may be used to add loads or exceeding abundantly above, more abundantly, advantage, exceedingly, very highly, beyond measure, more, superfluous, vehement or intensely passionate.

When the enemy comes in like a flood, the Lord has good news for us—He will raise a standard against the enemy’s plans!

“So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.” Isaiah 59:19 KJV emphases added.

2009 is the Year of Fullness of Blessings, yet we will be reminded that they come with a price!

Tet is the Hebrew word for 9 and along with fullness of blessings, comes other meanings that do not need to be taken out of context. These other meanings are words that can go either way. The other meanings for 9 include: END, JUDGMENT, SERPENT and TRIBULATION.

Before everyone does a “knee jerk” from the above meanings for the number 9, I do not make up meanings no more than I add to or take away from God’s Holy Scripture. However we must view the importance of their meanings in association with the Part One 2009 Word for the Year released on December 09, 2009. We must keep in mind that in prophetic words, just as in the base of all words, the Bible, context is extremely important. The Lord told me that in 2009 we are about to get a great training on the use of “context” to stop the “Negative Contest!” I heard the Lord say, anyone can start a panic if they get enough ears to hear their “cry of wolf.” [We can read the ending of the dispensation of God’s grace is found in the end of the Gospels—Matthew, Mark, Luke and John—in the New Testament.]. You do not have to be a prophet to know that eminent shaking and earthquakes, wars and rumors of wars, etc. will occur. The Lord clearly spoke to me while in Albany, Oregon at [“What is God Saying for 2009?” Elijah List Prophetic Conference](#), “Tell My people to never forget these Words that are already written, “Look up for your redemption draws near!” How we view this is critical to others who look at Christians for the answers to show them the Love of the Father. Let’s point them upwards!

“And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.” Luke 21:28 KJV emphases added.

Another way to say it is, “Be upbeat, not downcast oh my soul, because God is about to return and take us unto the banqueting table, because His banner over us is LOVE!”

Another word that grabs everyone, the Lord said to begin to teach on the balance of what is true Godly judgment!

Moses was receiving Judgment while pronouncing blessings for all Israel!

Moses began this adventure way back at Mt. Sinai and traversed until his appointed time of completion at Mt. Nebo. However, he knew from God's sure Word of judgment that he would not go into Canaan. God was proud of Moses, and God was about to bring Him to His place of waiting in a paradise until His rewards are given in heaven, yet God reminded Moses of his anger and disobedience when he struck the rock at Meribah. God did this just before taking him off this earth from Mt. Nebo. This was written more for the future leaders of Israel and for all others until this day—God keeps His Words and they are just and true.

Judgment of God is Sure and Just. Did God act in an evil way when He punished Moses for striking the rock rather than speaking to it? A first response we might quickly accuse God. The Bible shows God's righteousness in punishing Moses. Moses rebelled against God. He did not trust God's way of communicating with and helping His people. Thus, Moses did not respect God's holy purity. This was not the end of Moses; it was the end of a lesson in obedience!

Acting for God, Moses did not show the trusting, respectful obedience of God's chosen leader. He deserved punishment. A leader cannot take God's place and make God's decisions for Him. A leader must always point people to God and His way. Leaders are always held to a higher accountability than anyone because they can effect so many for good or bad. God's judgment for Moses and Aaron did not stop them from fulfilling their destiny for all Israel, it only ensured they were not to go in and possess the land. They indeed are in heaven where they should be, yet the judgment taught Israel and hopefully us, that we could not be God's leader without a great cost!

The price we pay will be according to the amount of obedience we are willing to follow for His perfect will.

2009 will continue to be a year of more shaking in the area of leadership being sifted for purification as fine flour before God's bread is complete. This is a good thing, because many leaders will be justly turned into paths that if the love of His judgment were not invoked, then others would suffer along with the deeds from wrongful leadership.

2009-A YEAR OF UNDERSTANDING OF REAL JUSTICE AND JUDGMENT OF GOD.

We must begin to re-think Judgment.

Another aspect you may not have viewed through the lenses of the Holy Spirit's truth training is found in the new testament in the form of a parable of the Unjust Judge.

18:1 One day Jesus told his disciples a story to illustrate their need for constant prayer and to show them that they must never give up.

2 "There was a judge in a certain city," he said, "who was a godless man with great contempt for everyone.

3 A widow of that city came to him repeatedly, appealing for justice against someone who had harmed her.

4 The judge ignored her for a while, but eventually she wore him out. 'I fear neither God nor man,' he said to himself,

5 'but this woman is driving me crazy. I'm going to see that she gets justice, because she is wearing me out with her constant requests!'"

6 Then the Lord said, "Learn a lesson from this evil judge.

7 Even he rendered a just decision in the end, so don't you think God will surely give justice to his chosen people who plead with him day and night? Will he keep putting them off?"

8 I tell you, he will grant justice to them quickly! But when I, the Son of Man, return, how many will I find who have faith?" Luke 18:1-7 NLT emphases added.

If Jesus used this to tell us that our persistence pays off, we must take Him to heart. God loves those who have desperation that can move your chronos time into your kairos moment of truth!

Moses prayed blessings over each of the twelve tribes before his time of departure at Mt. Nebo to rest with his forefathers. However, no doubt Moses thought of the names of the mountains and the valleys that he had to journey with specific battles necessary for advancement for God's chosen people to further the Father's Kingdom. However notice the blessings over the tribes of Joseph: (Joseph is representing adversity brings us to our triumph!)

"Moses said this about the tribes of Joseph: "May their land be blessed by the LORD with the choice gift of rain from the heavens, and water from beneath the earth; 14) with the riches that grow in the sun, and the bounty produced each month; 15) with the finest crops of the ancient mountains, and the abundance from the everlasting hills; 16) with the best gifts of the earth and its fullness, and the favor of the one who appeared in the burning bush. May these blessings rest on Joseph's head, crowning the brow of the prince among his brothers. 17) Joseph has the strength and majesty of a young bull; his power is like the horns of a wild ox. He will gore distant nations, driving them to the ends of the earth. This is my blessing for the multitudes of Ephraim and the thousands of Manasseh." Deuteronomy 33:13-17 NLT emphases added.

Moses knew from God's sure Word he would not go into Canaan land because of one past "troubling of the waters!" Meribah was the place that Moses lost his temper, his temporary respect for God's Word in front of all Israel, and thus was a place of judgment for his future assignment. It is interesting to note that the Hebrew word for Meribah is Meriybah. Meriybah is a wordplay (in the Hebrew) on the verb "to strive," or a "place of strife." God and Moses had enough of the grumbling and bickering from Israel. Now the bitter spirit they continually displayed not only cost them their inheritance in the Land of Promise, yet it brought their leader, Moses, into a "place of strife" and ultimate judgment with Jehovah Elohim; yet God loved Moses.

How will judgment be a blessing for us in this season of time? We have a choice between obedience and rebellion is the best way to point this lesson out to His own family. Outside the family of God, we are instructed to pray and pursue the lost at any cost so they do not meet God's sure judgment without Christ. Remember, judgment can be a great blessing if you are the one who is loving, living and obeying God! On the other hand, it is a balance sheet to denote the blessings and the rewards for our eternal abode with God. Nonetheless, judgment of God is real.

9 is also a number representing a Serpent.

Oddly enough, the serpent can be the symbol for both "curse" and "healing." 2009 is the year that if we do not practice God's Word, obey and watch to be in His perfect will and communion, then, we will have sins that open up the enemy's plans to come in and attempt to abort our birth of God's destiny for each of our lives. Also, remember that when Israel had again grumbled and complained while turning away from God's warnings, they brought upon themselves the curse of the snakebites. This is not what God or we want for His people!

Numbers 21:4-9

4 They traveled from Mount Hor along the route to the Red Sea, to go around Edom. But the people grew impatient on the way;

5 they spoke against God and against Moses, and said, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the desert? There is no bread! There is no water! And we detest this miserable food!"

6 Then the LORD sent venomous snakes among them; they bit the people and many Israelites died.

7 The people came to Moses and said, "We sinned when we spoke against the LORD and against you. Pray that the LORD will take the snakes away from us." So Moses prayed for the people.

8 The LORD said to Moses, "Make a snake and put it up on a pole; anyone who is bitten can look at it and live."

9 So Moses made a bronze snake and put it up on a pole. Then when anyone was bitten by a snake and looked at the bronze snake, he lived." KJV emphases added.

Suffering and adversity can be a call to repentance. Repeated complaints from the people brought God's just punishment. Repentance brought God's way for relief. Trust in God's chosen symbol lifted over the people brought healing. Therefore, we can view any hardship that we will encounter as an opportunity to look unto our Savior for deliverance. Today trust in God's lifted-up Son who brings salvation to our troubled nation.

If we stay focused on our adversity, we will miss the reason hardship happens to God-fearing family—strength for breakthrough!

2009 is to take tribulation to triumph!

"When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to the LORD thy God, and shalt be obedient unto his voice;" Deuteronomy 4:30 KJV emphases added.

Tsar, is the word for tribulation, (pronounced sawr), means a narrow place or a tight place.

This word tribulation we too often make sound so ghastly also represents a pebble. *Tsar* further speaks of being an opponent or an adversary. The word study is so beneficial when we view what God is speaking into our land for 2009. *Tsar*, or tribulation is no more than the meaning for our trials and afflictions! This is a word, tribulation, to be understood in its simplest of forms for us to understand as meaning trouble.

"And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience;" Romans 5:3 KJV emphases added.

Because Paul recognized that sufferings could have several good consequences, he rejoiced in sufferings. He did not deny the pain of the suffering but saw past its immediate circumstances to its final results in his life. Suffering teaches us to continue trying rather than quitting. This strengthens and matures our basic character as persons. In maturity we gain a new perspective even as we suffer, looking on life with hope rather than despair, a hope based on enduring experience with God and growing faith in God's promises as enforced in our life by the Holy Spirit.

Also, remember that it is the very trying of our faith that works the patience to reach the goal of our high calling of God. If we do not quit, then we will indeed go through the spiritual birth pains to bring to bear the fruit that God is calling us to in the year for Evangelism. Evangelism is to be birthed and all hell has tried to abort this process in the last couple of years. This is time to let those tribulations work patience in each of us!

“Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. 4) But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.” James

Notice the additional understanding brought about in the New Living Translation:

“3 For when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. 4) So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be strong in character and ready for anything.” James

Testing develops perseverance. Perseverance is victory over trial. Victory over trial presents the elect with the crown of life that God promises the chosen that love Him.

2009 will be a Year of Adversity causing Strength to Birth your Destiny!

Hannah’s Blessing is our best example for Birthing our Destiny in 2009.

1 Sam 1:1 Now there was a certain man from Ramathaim-zophim from the hill country of Ephraim, and his name was Elkanah the son of Jeroham, the son of Elihu, the son of Tohu, the son of Zuph, an Ephraimite.

2 He had two wives: the name of one was Hannah and the name of the other Peninnah; and Peninnah had children, but Hannah had no children.

3 Now this man would go up from his city yearly to worship and to sacrifice to the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were priests to the LORD there.

4 When the day came that Elkanah sacrificed, he would give portions to Peninnah his wife and to all her sons and her daughters;

5 but to Hannah he would give a double portion, for he loved Hannah, but the LORD had closed her womb.

6 Her rival, however, would provoke her bitterly to irritate her, because the LORD had closed her womb.

7 It happened year after year, as often as she went up to the house of the LORD, she would provoke her; so she wept and would not eat.”

This is our year to compare adversity as was displayed between Peninnah and Hannah, the two wives of Elkanah. The scripture tells us that Peninnah had children and Hannah had none. The reason is not the devil, not the physical, but scripture says God closed Hannah’s womb.

We have to understand the chronos seasons in relationship to kairos moments in our relationship with God and our destiny. This is where 2009 speaks to a “season of time” becoming a desperation in travail to usher in a kairos moment to birth our prophetic destiny.

“They that sow in tears shall reap in joy. 6) He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him.” Psalm 125:5,6 KJV emphases added.

This is an ideal narrative to demonstrate the way God views His chosen to press into a desperation that causes the Spirit of Travail to drop onto us for the Spirit of Conception to open our womb of fruitfulness and bring forth the Prophetic (forth telling) fruitfulness for our households, our communities, our states, our nation and the world!

In summary, (please read this entire account in 1 Samuel 1 and 2). Hannah had to bear the brunt of all Peninnah’s constant provoking until Hannah said, “Enough is enough!”

When her adversity reached its crest, Hannah could either choose to quit or dig her heels in and begin to pray. As she did, what I term as a “Spirit of Travail” consumed her and she had prayers that are best described as “groanings which cannot be uttered.”

“Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.” Romans 8:26

Who else can know the heart of God to pray except for the Holy Spirit of God! If we will obey when the tugging of the Holy Spirit is at our heart’s door, then we will move into a Spirit of Travail that will cause our “tribulation to birth our patience” to make this come full term!

“And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.” Romans 8:27 KJV emphases added.

Remember the enemy is going about “like” or mimicking a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. If we are the watchmen on the wall, if we are on our spiritual toes, then we will begin to “watch and pray” so that he can find nothing on us to allow access to abort our birth of destiny.

Hannah was goaded year after year and she took it until her “tribulation” worked on her patience enough to become utterly desperate for God to hear her travail and open her womb. This did not occur, however, for Hannah to show off her new son in front of Peninnah, the antagonist. Actually, God had a bigger plan, and Jehovah was wanting to replace the slacker priest, Eli and his sons with Prophetic Destiny. Hannah’s hardship was God’s way of strengthening her for the seed of a nation to be birthed that would speak volumes into the lineage of the birth of one similar to her (Mary) who would go through trials to bring forth the Christ Child—the Savior of the World. Hannah travailed, an obese and insolent priest named Eli could not even discern genuine travail over drunkenness. 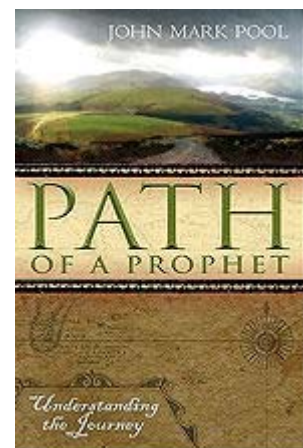
